Rubbish-Cavendish Road

Councillors' Report

Cllr. Bill Shelton (Saffron)

Boundary Road Having met a group of residents about the noise from Cadnet (National Grid) at the bottom of the road during the night and early morning, he had been frustrated at the lack of response and has passed the matter to Jon Ashworth, Member of Parliament for Leicester South. Hopefully, he may be more successful.

Cavendish Road He has also been dealing with rubbish being left out on the public footpath.

Cllr. Elly Cutkelvin (Saffron)

Aylestone Leisure Centre It will be open later at 7am rather than at 6.30 am. Some Ladies' Only sessions would be replaced by Adults' Only. This is to avoid duplication across the City.

Parking Review It has been suggested that painting double yellow lines around 34 corners within the area and having Residents' Parking Scheme could help to tackle the problem. A cycle lane along the whole of Saffron Lane has been promised.
